# Rediscover Jesus, Part 53: "Jesus' Determination and Desire" Luke 13:31-35 Pastor John Eom

#### Luke 13:31-35 (ESV)

<sup>31</sup> At that very hour some Pharisees came and said to him, "Get away from here, for Herod wants to kill you." <sup>32</sup> And he said to them, "Go and tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I finish my course. <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless, I must go on my way today and tomorrow and the day following, for it cannot be that a prophet should perish away from Jerusalem.'

<sup>34</sup>O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing! <sup>35</sup> Behold, your house is forsaken. And I tell you, you will not see me until you say, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!' "

### One Thing

Take refuge in Jesus Christ willingly for he alone is our Savior and security.

- 1) Our security is in our Savior's firm determination to die for undeserving sinners (vv.31-33)
- 2) Our security is in our Savior's tender desire for unwilling sinners (vv.34-35)
