Keep reforming as God’s people until God’s redemption story is done!

1. See Nehemiah 13:4-14: Our Parts in the Church.

Principle #1: The church is like an ecosystem that thrives when all of God’s people participate in its livelihood. *See also: Ephesians 4:16.*

2. See Nehemiah 13:15-22: Our Practice of Dependence.

Principle #2: We reinforce necessary dependence on God by obeying the principles of the Sabbath. *See also: Exodus 20:8-10.*

3. See Nehemiah 13:23-31: Our Pursuit of Holiness.

Principle #3: We can pursue holiness in our lives because trusting in Jesus makes us holy and accepted before God. *See also: Romans 12:1.*

→ **Life Application:**

- In light of Jesus making us holy and accepted before God, will I receive God’s gracious gift of salvation and commit to be his disciple by faith in him?
- In light of Jesus making us holy and accepted before God, how will I keep reforming in my pursuit of holiness, practice of dependence, or part in the church?
